It's not the guns... nor the legislators...?

We all know that guns don't shoot people, people do. Removing guns only hurts good guys. As a thought exercise, let's take that principle and apply it to electing our legislators.

Imagine legislators as the guns. Indeed, they are shooting at us in almost every area of our lives.

But just like the guns, they can only legally exercise the power that we, the electorate, give them.

We think of ways to educate people about guns; teach them not to be afraid of them; that they are tools, not scary entities with wills of their own. Only with a super-majority of changed heads/hearts, will the gun control madness stop.
