#### CS Lewis wrote,

"Of all tyrannies, a tyranny sincerely exercised for the good of its victims may be the most oppressive. It would be better to live under robber barons than under omnipotent moral busybodies. The robber baron's cruelty may sometimes sleep, his cupidity may at some point be satiated; but those who torment us "for our own good", will torment us without end, for they do so with the approval of their own conscience.

They may be more likely to go to Heaven, yet at the same time likelier to make a Hell of earth. This very kindness stings with intolerable insult.

To be "cured" against one's will and "cured" of states which we may not regard as disease, is to be put on a level of those who have not yet reached the age of reason or those who never will; to be classed with infants, imbeciles, and domestic animals."

I have reached the age of reason, and I am none of the above, neither infant, nor imbecile, nor domestic animal.

You have reached the age of reason, and you are none of the above.

They sound tyrannical to me, and in this moment, when tyranny threatens our way of life far more dangerously than any germ, we need to *Not* be isolated and pitted against one another, but we need to stand together as we are standing today.

United in this fight, one in this fight. Only then will we prevail in this fight.

## **Fingerprints**

I ask you to consider for a moment, your fingerprints. Stick with me...

There's not another set like that in all the world.

I ask you to consider an optical scan of your retina, in your eye, and the image that it casts.

It too can be used to recognize **you** out of all the people on the Earth.

We are unique. Period... but it seem as though only the security world recognizes that.

In the medical community, we seem to have come to believe that we're all identical, all requiring the same, exact thing... all over the world.

Your cardio-vascular system works exactly like mine, right? Your cardio-pulmonary system works just like mine, right?

Your endocrine and exocrine glandular system is identical to mine, right? Your skin, the largest organ in your body by the way, your skin's color, texture and sensitivity to sun and irritation, and its need to be shaven is identical to mine, right?

Who thinks like this?

This is neither medicine nor science, neither caring nor teaching.

But *medicine*, is about caring.

**Science** is about discovery.

Neither is about dogma, nor conformity to a business model designed within the six sigma limits of the bell curve, into which we all must dogmatically fit, whether we fit there or not.
